INFORMATION SHEET

1. **ENTRY** must be submitted no later than Tuesday, March 12, 2019 by Midnight online. (**Enter as early as possible** – (Site will be open for changes-ONLY (NO NEW ENTRY-JUST CHANGES) until 4:00 pm Wednesday))
2. Include best times, heights and distances in meet competition on your online entry blank.
3. **NO COACHES MEETING** will be held on the day of the meet, However, Packets maybe pick-up at the first tent to the right as you enter into the pass gate (Double drive-in gates) March 16, 2019 starting at 7:00 A.M. **Coaches may pay entry fee (\$40.00 per team) at this time- Checks or Money Ordesr made payable to Raines High School (NO PERSONAL CHECK).**
4. **Lewis Siplin 1600 Meter Run is a special Event.**
5. Spikes no longer than 1/8" will be permitted on Raines Track and Runway Surface, which is a sprintax 200 running surface (rubber).
6. The discus and shot put circles are made of concrete.
7. If an event doesn't have enough participants, it will be run as a Final.
8. Starting height for the pole vault will be 10'6"for boys, 7'0" for girls, the high jump 6'0" for boys, and 4'6" for the girls.
9. Coaches are requested to keep their athletes out of the track oval and/or off the football field. Bleachers will be available for coaches and their teams.
10. The thirty- two hundred (3200) meter relay will be run as a Final at 8:00 A.M. on time.
11. Cut off marks in field events for measurement.
